A WHP Training Day will be held at Greenlands Equestrian Centre on Friday 7th April with subsidised training from top trainers Susie Gibson and Vikki Smith. Susie has trained Champion WHPs at HOYS, RIHS, etc and Vikki has an incredible record both on the flat and with WHPs.

Riders do not need to be a BCPS Member, but Members will get reduced rates and priority booking. Rider places will be strictly limited, but spectators are also encouraged to participate in the sessions.

To take part:

- At every show which you attend, anywhere, from Friday 27th January to Friday 31st March 2023, record your attendance and results on your card. Your card must be signed by the show secretary at each show to be valid.
- Points will be allocated as follows:

AE Arena Eventing WHP M&M Working Hunter Pony Mountain & Moorland

DR Dressage WHP PL Working Hunter Pony Plaited

SJ Show Jumping (WHP points can count for either M&M or PL, but not both)

- Each pony/rider combination can collect points in up to 3 disciplines.
- Registered participants must send in their completed points card to arrive no later than Friday 31st March.

- Every rider who submits a completed points card will receive a Pat Parker Legacy Memorial Rosette.
- Two prizes of one free 30 minute private training session, with Susie Gibson and Vikki Smith, will be awarded to the Senior rider and to the Junior (16 and under) rider with the highest points total.
- Four runners up prizes of a free place in a one hour group training session, with Susie Gibson and Vikki Smith, will also be awarded.
- Prize winners must be prepared to travel to Greenlands Equestrian Centre, Wreay, Carlisle CA4 0RR on Friday 7th April for the WHP Training Day, otherwise their prize will be passed down the line. Stabling on-site may be available, please book directly with the centre.
- Additionally, 24 places in one hour group lessons will be available to any rider who has submitted a points card, at hugely subsidised cost thanks to the Pat Parker Legacy and BCPS, for which we are very grateful. BCPS Members will be given priority booking.
- Each rider at the WHP Training Day will be given one free spectator pass.
